

## Dear City of Elkhorn Residents,

LRS (formerly known as Badgerland Disposal) is proud to announce new curbside collection service for residents in the City of Elkhorn beginning January 2024. LRS will provide weekly refuse and every other week recycling collection for all residents.

LRS will deliver one new trash cart and one new recycle cart before your service starts in January. If you wish to have the smaller cart option (65gal), please call 608-580-0580 or email <a href="mailto:Bltownservice@LRSrecycles.com">Bltownservice@LRSrecycles.com</a> by 1/30/24. Please continue to use your current trash and recycle carts through the end of the year and leave carts at the curb on your last service day for removal by the current hauler. LRS will only service the new carts which will be delivered to each home in December.

### **COLLECTION PROGRAM GUIDELINES:**

- Trash and recycling must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your designated collection day,
- On your service day, containers should be placed 3 feet apart & 3 feet from any obstruction. (Walking between containers is a good rule of thumb, or place one container on the left side of the driveway and the other container on the right on days when both trash and recycle are scheduled.)
- All waste / recycling materials must be INSIDE of the carts, waste or bags outside of the carts will not be taken, and
- On holiday weeks we operate on a <u>one-day</u> delay, when the holiday <u>FALLS ON A WEEKDAY</u>.

### **SERVICE CALENDAR:**

Enclosed please find your service calendar which outlines your collection schedule. Trash will be picked up weekly and recycle will be picked up every other week.

# WASTE (trash, garbage, refuse):

Your trash cart will be serviced **every week** based on the enclosed calendar. Solid waste is what most of us think of as "trash", "refuse" or "garbage" that is produced at home, work or leisure. This category does NOT include any of the recyclable items listed below, any household hazardous waste, liquid latex paint, yard waste, appliances or electronics.

\*\*IMPORTANT NOTE: These items are not allowed and will not be handled by LRS for curbside pickup:

- > <u>NO HAZARDOUS GOODS</u>: no flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint, batteries, household hazardous waste, banned electronic waste, engine parts or tires.
- > NO YARD WASTE: no grass clippings, leaves, branches, soil, dirt, sod, hot ashes, etc.
- > NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS: no concrete, rock, demolition debris, large construction waste items.







### **BULK ITEM SERVICE:**

- > Two (2) bulk items are included per home each month. Resident must call/email at least 48 hours in advance of monthly bulk pick-up day to schedule. No freon appliances, no tires, no waste oil, no electronics, no waste liquids, no batteries.
- > <u>Bulk "pay-per-item"</u> option is available year round. Please email <u>bltownservice@lrsrecycles.com</u> or call **(608) 580-0580** to arrange services. Item(s) must be <50 lbs. and manageable by one person (or broken down into manageable piece), no yard waste, no tires, no hazardous material, no waste oils, and no liquids. Regular bulk items (mattress, sofa, table, chair, etc.) and non-freon appliances, \$55/each, freon appliances \$65/each.

#### **RECYCLING:**

Your recycling cart will be serviced <u>bi-weekly</u> (every other week) based on the enclosed calendar. The following items are banned from Wisconsin landfills and as a result should be placed in your recycling cart for proper processing, handling and/or reuse:

- Aluminum containers, glass containers, steel containers (tin/aluminum cans)
- Bi-metal containers (i.e. containers made from a combination of steel and aluminum)
- Corrugated cardboard (all corrugated cardboard cut into pieces no larger than 3' x 3')
- Magazines and other materials printed on similar paper
- Newspaper and other materials printed on newsprint
- Mixed paper
- Plastic containers #1 #7 milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, soda and water bottles, etc.
