Recreation board meetings are held once a month at 5:30 PM at the City Administration Building: 311 Seymour Court. There is no July or December meeting.

RESIDENCY

A person is considered a resident if the citizen resides within the corporate boundaries of the City of Elkhorn, not the school district or postal city.

NOTE: Residents in the Elkhorn Area School District will be considered residents for all programs held at a school facility. A person is NOT considered a resident if any of the following are true:

A City of Elkhorn business owner that lives outside the City of Elkhorn limits.

Residence outside the City of Elkhorn limits: Town of Lafayette, Town of Geneva, Town of Delavan, Town of Sugar Creek. Cannot provide proof of residency when registering for programs.

CANCELLATION

Updates are posted to Facebook: Elkhorn Recreation Department. We will do our best to update this communication method as soon as possible. Please check them frequently. We reserve the right to cancel any activity or program.

MINIMUM ENROLLMENT

All programs are subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment is not met. When this is the case, pre-registered participants will be contacted and be offered a refund or credit on account. We make every effort to avoid cancellations.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All instructors, participants, and guardians are expected at all times to be positive and respectful to all involved. They must be supportive and proactive in all situations, and may otherwise be asked to leave the activity or session.

Register as soon as possible so an activity is not cancelled due to low enrollment.

DEADLINES

NOTHING KILLS A PROGRAM QUICKER than everyone waiting until the last minute to register. Please **REGISTER IN ADVANCE OF THE DEADLINE!** At some point, we must determine if enrollment is sufficient to hold the activity. Your cooperation will assist us in providing the best organization and administration of recreation programs.

PROGRAM FEES

Program fees are due at the time of registration. Failure to make payment on outstanding fees may result in inability to participate in the program. All fees are subject to change.

ACTIVITY CHANGES

Due to circumstances beyond our control, some activities may require time or location changes. All participants will be notified, when possible.

REFUND

- **1 Week Prior to a Program Start Date:** Full refunds will not be issued. Participants can receive a 50% refund or 100% credit on account less than 1 week prior. *This policy excludes Sunset Camp, please see below.*
- **After the Program Start Date:** A request for a 50% refund or 100% credit on account will be determined on a case by case basis and will need approval from the Recreation Director. Factors that may affect 50% refund request: instructor cost, material cost & insufficient time to contact waitlist participants.
- **Program Canceled by Rec Department:** A full refund will be issued. Cancellations occur when a program does not meet the minimum registration requirements. The City reserves the right to cancel or combine any program or class due to insufficient registration or for other reasons that would prevent the department from providing a quality activity.
- **Missed Classes:** Refunds will not be issued for individual classes missed or vacations. Missed classes will not be made-up nor will the participants attend any other class in its place.
- **Sunset Camp:** Due to the high demand of this program, a full refund for Sunset Camp will not be issued less than 2 weeks prior from the program start date. Sunset Camp participants will be eligible for a 50% refund or 100% credit within 2 weeks prior to the program start date. No refund will be given after the program has already started due to staffing cost, material cost and insufficient time to contact waitlist participants.

PHOTOGRAPHY

We use pictures of participants in brochures and displays to inform others of our recreational opportunities. We will not identify individuals by name. If you do not want a photo taken, please tell the photographer and or instructor.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

We welcome all individuals and families from our community to our programs and facilities regardless of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or disability. If you are a person with a disability and would like information on programs or park facilities, call us at (262) 741-5114. Please notify us at least three (3) business days in advance to help us accommodate your request.

We are devoted to conducting programs or activities in the safest manner possible. However, participants and parents registering their child in recreation programs must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities. The department continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions. If you find a safety hazard in one of our parks or facilities, please call 262-723-2233.

INSURANCE COVERAGE

Please recognize that the Elkhorn Recreation Department does not carry medical or hospital insurance for injuries or illness that participants may sustain in programs. Prior to registering, please review your health insurance policy for coverage. Absence of personal health insurance coverage does not make the City of Elkhorn Recreation Department responsible for payment of a participant's medical coverage.

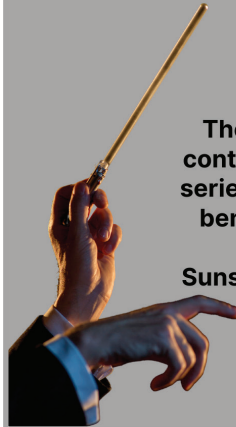

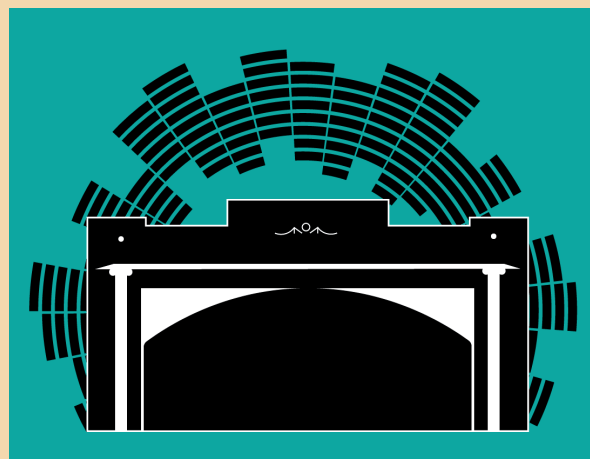

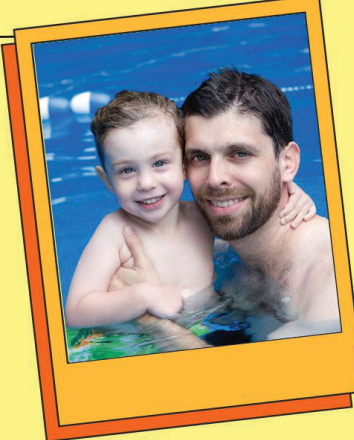

SUNSET POOL

MEMBERSHIPS: Family Memberships are for parents and children living in the same household. Family passes do not include nannies, babysitters, nurses, caregivers, cousins, nieces, nephews or out of town guests. If grandparents would like to take the place of parent(s) – this is allowable under certain circumstances and requests must be made in person at the recreation center. A \$25 fee will be issued if any changes to a membership are made after the purchase is complete (adding or replacing a member, or any other changes,...). **No refund** will be issued if the membership was not used or was rarely used. **Keep your card for next year! \$3 fee to replace a lost membership card.**

CAREGIVER PASS: A caregiver pass may only be purchased by family membership owners. The pass can be used by multiple caregivers but by only one at a time. The pass must only be used when with children of the family who purchased card. Caregiver must be 14 & up.

SUPERVISION: **Every child age 6 or under must be within arms reach of an adult or guardian at all times.** Our lifeguards are trained with safety as the highest importance for every guest, but an extra set of eyes on children in or near the water is a bonus. A child age 10 and up may be allowed to come to the pool without a guardian. If pool guidelines are not followed, they will be asked to leave or be picked up.

SWIM DIAPERS: All guest who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper. They are available at the front desk for \$1.

WEATHER: Follow our Facebook page. Please check the weather before you come to the pool. If the air temperature is 65° (real feel) or less, we do not open or could close early. If we need to close because of lightening or thunder, the wait period is 30 minutes from the last thunder. If the weather does not get better, we will issue you a hand stamp and you may return later. If you cannot return later and the storm is unexpected and you had just arrived at pool within the last hour, a day pass will be issued in form of a coupon. No cash refunds will be given.

SWIM TESTS: Anyone less than 12 years old will need to pass the swim test to go in the deep end including drop slide and diving boards.

- Swim tests will be held every hour on the hour.
- Swim tests to receive a wristband will be done by a certified lifeguard.
- If you pass the swim test you will receive a free wristband to keep.
- If you lose your wristband, a new one can be purchased for \$1 at the front desk.



LOCKER ROOMS: Please bring your own padlock if you wish to lock your items in a locker. We are not responsible for any stolen items. There is a lost and found at the front desk.

LOUNGERS, CHAIRS, & TABLES: If you or your children are not going to use a chair, please do not put your items on numerous chairs. Items may be placed in the grass or in a locker or cubby.

BEHAVIOR: At all times, children and adults are expected to act respectful to each other and staff. If a patron is not following policy, they will be warned. If action further warrants, they may be asked to leave without getting hand stamped. If action is repeated, they may not be able to return for a period of time or all summer long.

CONCESSIONS: **Per WI state law, no coolers, nor food of any kind is allowed into the facility.** We can however stamp your hand if you wish to leave and return, as there are picnic benches outside the pool gate. Water is the only item that may be brought into the facility in a clear container. If you have a special diet concern, please talk to the pool manager. If you are unhappy with our concessions at any time, please ask to speak to our pool manager. No drinks or food in the pool or on the pool edge.

FLOTATION DEVICES: No floatation devices are allowed on any day and this includes water wings, unless attached to a belt or vest that is coast guard approved, eg. Puddle Jumper. Any vest that is approved should always say on the inside label "coast guard approved" or "USCG." Approved life vests are available to borrow at the front desk. Toys are allowed if smaller than 10". Please ask approval at front desk.

JUST WATCHING? If you enter the facility, you must pay the admission fee, even if you are not swimming. If the child is above the age of 10 and you do not want to pay but still want to watch them, there are benches outside the fence for your relaxation. If you are picking a child up, just let staff know your child's name and we will announce it!

LARGE GROUPS: All camps, daycares and organized groups over the size of 10 people must prearrange their visits with staff at least 2 weeks in advance through the Recreation Department. The adult to child ration must be 8:1. An adult must be in arms reach at all times with those age 6 years old and younger. Groups will pay the daily admission per person upon arrival. Advance payment is not available.

TOBACCO USAGE/VAPE PENS: Vape pens, chewing tobacco, cigarettes are not allowed in the facility or parking lot.

DIVING: Hop-dives, front flips, twists and the cannonball will be allowed. Back flips are not allowed due to risk of injury.

SEMI-PRIVATE SWIM LESSONS

DEADLINE: One week before the session starts

AGE: 6 months +

REQUIREMENT: See Swim Lesson Level Descriptions

FEE: Parent/Child: \$25R / \$35R Per Session
Preschool-Level 3/4: \$45R / \$55 NR Per Session

LOCATION: Sunset Pool, 320 Devendorf Street

BRING: Wear a swimsuit and bring a towel.

DESCRIPTION: We will help your child develop proper techniques and skills in a group of up to 3 students. Determine their starting level by using the level descriptions.

TEMPERATURE: Cancellation due to the air/water temperature is up to the Rec Department's discretion. We will email and call if the class is cancelled.



WEATHER-RELATED MAKE-UPS: There will not be any rain make-up dates this summer. Any dates cancelled by the rec department will be pro-rated as a credit to your Rec Desk account. If you do not to attend a lesson for any reason other than a cancellation made by the Rec Department, there will not be a make-up class scheduled.

A. Sunset Park- Elkhorn’s premier park! This is the location of our brand new state of the art Sunset Pool as well as the historic Elkhorn Band Shell. The park offers a wide array of recreational activities including: 4 baseball/softball fields, swimming pool, 2 basketball courts and 2 playgrounds. The ADA park is next to the Lions Den and is wheelchair accessible. The Lions Den is the only pavilion in Sunset Park and is available to rent for your private parties. There are bathrooms at this pavilion as well. Port-a-potties are available near the baseball diamonds when the weather permits. Location: 200 Devendorf Street.

B. Temnitz Park- A nature resource park. The walking path is a great place to enjoy bird watching or a relaxing walk. Location: At the end of Greenfield Street.

C. Broad Street Park- This is a neighborhood park where kids can play on the playground or in the sand. Location: Corner of North Broad Street and Second Avenue.

D. Tasch Park- It offers a playground and t-ball field, basketball courts and recreational open space. Location: 12 1st Ave.

E. Pocket Park- It is perfect to stop and enjoy your coffee or meet a friend. This park is small in nature but able to host the right event if planned appropriately and is the home-base for Oktoberfest every year. Location: N. Wisconsin Street across from the downtown square between buildings.

F. Harris Park- Consists of two baseball and one softball field. The softball field is called Red, and baseball fields are called the Varsity and Colt fields. Harris Park has a concession stand, a pavilion with bathrooms and a playground area, as well basketball hoops that are right next to the school. Location: 1 S. 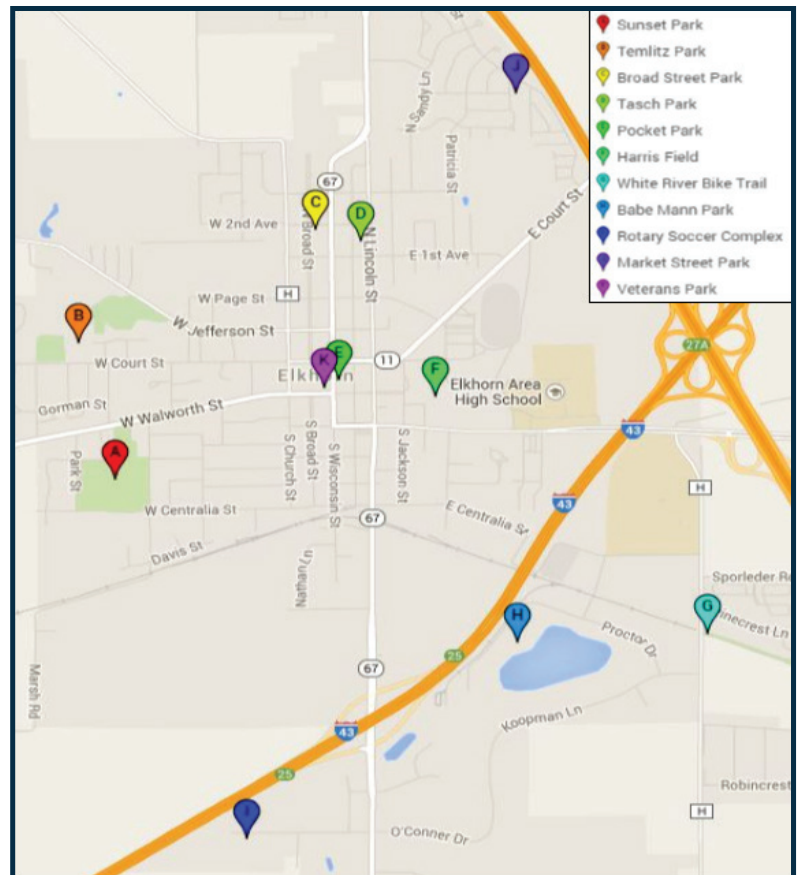
G. White River Bike Trail- Hwy H, just south of Gateway Technical college. This multi-use 12 mile crushed limestone trail follows a former railroad bed. It connects Elkhorn to Burlington. Passes available for purchase and the Elkhorn Chamber of Commerce.

H. Babe Mann Park- Elkhorn’s largest park sprawling over 34 acres surrounding Elkhorn Lake. Canoeing and fishing are allowed. Swimming is prohibited. The pavilion is a new as of 2023. Bathrooms, picnic tables, and benches are provided. A one-mile trail surrounds the lake for cross-country skiing, hiking, walking/ jogging or biking. Location: City Industrial Park, 900 Proctor Drive.

I. Rotary Park- Three soccer fields, a concession stand, playground and picnic area. Location: O’Connor Drive off of Hwy 67.

J. Market Street Park- Located in Harvest Pointe Subdivision. This park is ADA accessible & features play equipment, walking paths and a shelter. Location: Corner of Market St. and Heather Dr.

K. Veterans Park- Plenty of shade trees and a few picnic tables. Location: Downtown on the square.



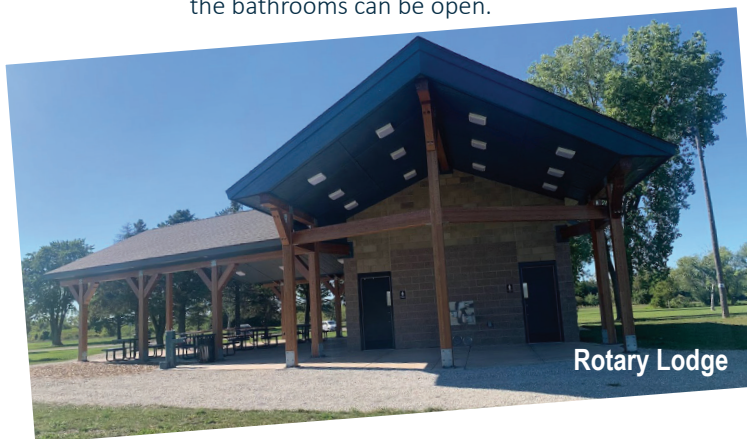
Reservations

- **RESERVATION:** Reservations are accepted for the current calendar year only. Applicant must be the primary contact, planner & payor. The fee is based on the applican'ts residency, not the attending guests' residency.
- **AVAILABILITY:** Call for 262-741-5114 Monday- Friday, 8:00AM- 4:30PM.
 - **Payment is due in full at the time of rental. A date will not be held without payment.**
- **PUBLIC EVENT:** If your event is open to the public, you will be required to attain an Event Permit through City Hall in addition to your rental through the Elkhorn Recreation Department.
- **WAYS TO RESERVE:**
 - **BABE MANN ROTARY PAVILION & RECREATION CENTER RENTAL:** In person at the Elkhorn Recreation Center: 200 Devendorf St.
 - **OTHER PAVILIONS:** In person or call 262-741-5114. Have your credit card handy to pay over the phone.
- **CANCELLATION POLICY:**
