

Dear Elkhorn Resident,

Beginning on or about Monday, August 29, 2022 work will begin on the 2022 Elkhorn Stormwater Improvement Project on the Vacant, City Owned Lot located adjacent to your property – Please see the Attached Area Map

The project calls for building a storm water infiltration basin on the property and involve the excavation, removal and off-site disposal of significant volumes of existing clay/dirt soil as well as the import and installation of storm sewer drainage pipes, stone base material and engineered soils to build the infiltration structure itself.

The site will be accessed via the existing paved driveway as well as a temporary stone tracking pad adjacent to the existing paved driveway which is located between 904 Gorman Street and 21 West Street, per the plans called for by the City of Elkhorn. Any damage and disruption to these areas will be repaired upon completion of the project.

The anticipated project completion date is on or about October 28, 2022
